This template is provided to assist investigators in developing study-specific documents and should be used as appropriate. Investigators are not required to use this template.

The actual structure and content of what is tracked should be adjusted to the type of study that is being performed. For example, multi-center studies should report data for the study as a whole, as well as by site. The following is an outline of the type of information that should be tracked. It is meant to guide and assist investigators and it is not required that this format be followed.
