

Planned USRDS Publications: Requirement for Processing Approvals (required prior to manuscript submission)

Privacy assurance: Planned publications based upon USRDS data must be submitted for privacy assurance review to the USRDS Coordinating Center (CC) at USRDS@niddk.nih.gov. Please provide a **submission ready** manuscript (no mark ups, comments or highlights) that includes an author list and all supplemental documentation; the document name should pertain to the manuscript title Include the following information in the submission email:

- USRDS DUA number
- Title of manuscript
- Journal to be submitted
- “USRDS manuscript” in the subject line

Incomplete submissions will not be accepted or approved but returned to the authors

Remember, per the Data Use Agreement section H, “The Requester shall not publish or otherwise disclose the Data in the files to any person or organization unless the Data have been aggregated (that is, combined into groupings of Data such that the Data are no longer specific to any individuals within each grouping), and no cells (aggregates of Data) contain information on fewer than eleven individuals or allow for calculation of cells with fewer than eleven individuals. The Requester shall not publish or otherwise disclose the Data in the files to any person or organization on fewer than five providers or facilities or Data from which individual providers or facilities could be inferred.

Your manuscript must contain the following citation for use of the USRDS data.

U.S. Renal Data System. 2025 USRDS Annual Data Report: Epidemiology of Kidney Disease in the United States. National Institutes of Health, National Institute of Diabetes and Digestive and Kidney Diseases, Bethesda, MD, 2025.

Also required is inclusion of the following publication disclaimer:

“The data reported here have been supplied by the United States Renal Data System (USRDS). The interpretation and reporting of these data are the responsibility of the author(s) and in no way should be seen as an official policy or interpretation of the U.S. government.”

The USRDS suggests the following data availability statement should the publisher require it:

“The datasets used and/or analyzed during the current study are available from the United States Renal Data System (USRDS) upon Data Use Agreement (DUA) approval. Per the DUA between the authors and NIDDK, the rerelease of the data or the deposition of data into publicly available repositories or to individuals is not allowed.”

The manuscript will not be submitted for final review and approval until the manuscript complies with the following:

- The manuscript and all supplementary materials were submitted including
 - Author list
 - Compliance with section H of the DUA regarding small number suppression
 - USRDS disclaimer
 - USRDS reference in citation list
- The name of the journal for planned submission
- The USRDS Data Use Agreement number or attached DUA approval letter
